Our client required a flexible lighting solution for some of their buildings. We were given the opportunity to submit a design proposal.

The buildings created a problem from a lighting perspective in so far as many were designed in the 1960's and had relatively low floor to ceiling heights.

Since we viewed matters from a lighting compliance point of view, our initial design and sampling was based around a semi-recessed luminaire with a side light element to illuminate the ceiling.

This worked from an LG7 position however the client required a clean ceiling line.

Given some version's of the MH fitting are 3.2 metres long, we laid down a specific extrusion tool so that our client had the best looking solution possible including a small recess to create some depth.
